2012-2013 Tuition Schedule

Registration

Registration reserves a place in a class for a student on a priority-based waiting list. Registration opens February 1, 2012 for all students.

Re-enrolling Students: The student's account must be current in order to be registered for classes.

Financial Aid: Students applying for financial aid will be registered when a financial aid application has been submitted, reviewed by the Finance Committee and a specific grant has been offered and accepted in writing. Those requesting financial aid may proceed with regular payments until a decision is made by the Finance Committee. At that time, the account may be adjusted accordingly.

Waiting List: In the event a class is full, the student is placed on a priority-based waiting list when registration is paid. The family of a student on the waiting list is not required to make tuition payments, but should be prepared to catch up on all payments that would have accrued from July forward should a position become available before the start of the school year.

Registration fee refunds may be given under the following circumstances:

- A student on the waiting list is not ultimately enrolled.
- After the interview, the school is unable to accept the student.

Except as noted above, the REGISTRATION FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE OR TRANSFERABLE.

Kindergarten: Five-year-olds have the option of five half-days, all day, or a combination of half-days per week.

Middle School Surcharge: Each 6th, 7th, and 8th grade student is required to pay an additional \$39.17 per month or \$470 per year to help offset some of the higher and additional costs per student in the Middle School program. There is an additional cost for books.

Late Payment Fee: With the exception of full payment by July 10th, **tuition is due by the first of each month with a 10 day "grace period."** Unless specifically prearranged in writing to the Finance Committee, a **\$20 late fee will be assessed on the 10th of the month** along with a reminder letter by mail as specified in the Parent Manual.

PLEASE NOTE:

- A student's registered class position could be forfeited to a waiting list position if that family's tuition account is not kept up to date monthly.
- Students enrolling after school begins will be charged tuition proportionate to the actual school days remaining, rather than the above full-year schedule. Tuition payments will divide evenly over the remaining months through June.
- The Multiple Student Discount applies only to families with students who are living in the same household.

Family Referral Credit

The Eugene Christian Board of Directors has approved a Family Referral Credit for the 2012-13 school year. If a currently enrolled family refers a family or families to ECS for enrollment, and the family subsequently enrolls one or more student(s) in a class that has an opening, the referring family will receive credit to their tuition account equal to \$18 per month for each Pre K & K-5 student enrolled and \$36 per month for each Grade 1 through Grade 8 student enrolled, paid over 10 months, September through June. If a new family later withdraws from the school, then the monthly credit will cease. This credit will be applied to the referring family's account only for the 2012-13 school year, and will not apply for any subsequent years.

Note: The tuition credit you receive may be considered income to you for tax purposes, so you may need to contact your tax advisor.

Example: The Smith family has one child in 4th grade currently enrolled at ECS for the 2012-13 school year. They tell the Jones' about ECS, and the Jones family later enrolls their two children in grades 4 and 6. The discount would start to be applied to the Smith's account in September after the Jones' children begin the school year. The credit to the Smiths' would be calculated as follows:

Jones' enroll a 6th & 4th student

Monthly credit to be applied to the Smith family tuition account for 10 months (September thru June) \$72 or \$720 for the year

Smith's regular tuition payment per month, July & August: \$485

Smith's new tuition payment September thru June per month: \$413
