

ECS WEEKLY PROGRESS REPORT EXPLANATION

Eugene Christian Middle School Athletes must take a weekly progress report around to all of their teachers at the beginning of each period on Thursdays. Once the report has been completed it must be placed in the progress report box, on the desk of Ms. Honor.

To be eligible:

- 1. The student athlete must be passing all of his/her classes.
 - a. NO more than 1 focus area behind combined.
 - NO more than 2 cooldowns red combined.
- 2. The student athlete must have acceptable behavior. One unacceptable behavior (see Parent/Student Handbook) will be allowed per week. However, if the athlete has unacceptable behavior in the same class two weeks in a row, they will be ineligible.
- 3. <u>Student athletes must attend a full day of school on the day of games or competitions. Unless approved by Mr. A or Ms. Honor beforehand.</u>
- 4. The completed report must be turned in on Thursday afternoon.

Consequences of being ineligible are:

- Academic (not passing all classes, didn't turn in a progress report, or didn't turn it in on time - Thursday afternoon).
 - The student athlete will not participate, sit on the bench or travel with the team to the next week's competitions.
 - The student athlete should still attend regular practice.
- Behavior (this means more than one unacceptable behavior in a week or two weeks of unacceptable behavior in the same class).
 - The student athlete will not participate, sit on the bench or travel with the team to the next competition.
 - The student athlete will write a letter of apology to the staff member or student in which the unacceptable behavior was directed.
 - The student athlete should still attend practice.

Ms. Honor will notify the athletes if they are ineligible. They and their parents will receive an email stating why they are ineligible.
